Dear Parents/Carers,

When parents accept a place for their child at this school it is on the condition that they will actively support the wearing of a school uniform in the correct colours.

Please take notice of the following requirements:

Uniform

The school uniform is **red, grey and white**.

Red - Cardigans, fleeces, sweatshirts, polo-shirts and t-shirts.

Red and White - Gingham dresses

Grey - Trousers, skirts, knee length shorts, cardigans, pinafore dresses, tights and socks.

White - Shirts, blouses, socks, tights, polo-shirts and t-shirts.

Most items of school uniform can be purchased at local supermarkets and department stores.

Sweatshirts, sweat cardigans, fleeces, reversible coats and polo-shirts all with the SCHOOL LOGO are available from:

School uniform for the Nursery is optional, and comprises of red jogging bottoms and a sweatshirts or cardigan.

Red Reading Bags - must be purchased from Casey's School Wear. The school office will carry a small number of book bags for purchase. These are the only bags that are allowed in school along with PE bags.

Footwear

Children should wear black plain shoes and footwear which is safe and promotes good foot health: the soles and heels should be of modest depth. They should not be of the 'flip-flop' or 'sling-back' or similar style, nor made of wood or other rigid material. If Wellington boots are worn in inclement weather, your child should bring a change of footwear for use inside school.

Hair

Girls must have their hair tied back if they have long hair. Boys must not have designs cut into their hair.

Nail Varnish

Nail varnish and false nails are not to be worn (your child will be asked to remove any nail varnish in the school office).

Jewellery

Jewellery is not permitted at school. Rings and brooches can be a potential hazard to your child and to other children.

Children who have pierced ears must only wear plain sleepers of small diameter or small studs.

Teachers will not be prepared to search for lost items brought into school in breach of this rule, nor will the school accept any responsibility.

Children are not allowed to bring mobile phones into school.

Children are allowed to wear watches, please ensure they are not alarm watches as these disturb other children when they are working. Watches will be the child's responsibility - the school cannot be expected to look after them.

PE Kit

Indoor P.E.

All children require red shorts, house colour t-shirt and plimsolls or trainers (a change of shoes is required when the children do PE).

Shorts, T-shirts and PE bags are available to purchase or order from Casey's School Wear.

Training shoes are not encouraged as they are primarily used as outdoor footwear.

Outdoor P.E.

Much of course depends on the weather - in warm weather the same dress as above may be suitable, but in the winter or during cooler weather black track suit bottoms are ideal, to be worn over the top of sports shorts and t-shirt. Trainers or plimsolls may be worn in the playground. They should be different to the ones worn during the day.
